The Call for Compositions presents a unique opportunity for a small group of selected student composers to have their work displayed at the conference and heard by MMEA members. Compositions will be displayed at the conference, along with recordings and CD players for individual listening. Students will be recognized at a session during the conference led by a professional who works in composition or arranging. Please note that only one composition is allowed per student, with a maximum of five compositions per school. Accepted composers will be notified during the second week of January. All others will be informed in writing.

Students must adhere to the following criteria:

1. Must be a student in grades K-12 in a Massachusetts school.
2. Composer must be unpublished.
3. Must be willing to attend the conference if composition is selected.
4. Must be recommended by music teacher who is an MENC member.
5. Must provide a short biography and photograph of the student.

Compositions must adhere to the following criteria:

1. Must be submitted in written form. (Students are encouraged to use a notation program for legibility).
2. Must be recorded and submitted on tape or CD. (Performance of compositions is the responsibility of the composer).
3. May be for piano, instrumental solo, vocal solo, small ensemble, or large ensemble.
4. Must be under ten minutes in length.

Submit the following:

1. Written score
2. Recording of the composition
3. Photograph and short biography of the composer
4. Photocopy of the music teacher's MENC membership card
5. Application form (below)
