Casual concerts present an opportunity for small ensembles (no more than 8 instrumentalists or 25 singers) to perform at the All State Conference in a flexible environment. These performances provide an opportunity for both conference attendees and young performers to experience music in a unique atmosphere.

*Applicant directors should remember that this is not a formal concert and the experience should be likened to that of performing at holiday times to provide atmosphere. The audience may not be totally attentive and this is not a sign of disrespect for the group. Some Casual Concerts will be held in the lobby of the ballroom area, after concert hours. Others will be held in the lobby of the conference area.*

- Each group is limited to 30 minutes of performance time, **including** set up and break down.
- Directors will be responsible for providing all necessary equipment.
- Transportation to and from the conference is the responsibility of the school district.

In order for a group to be considered for a casual concert performance, the director must:

1. Complete the application below. This also serves as notice that the director has read and understands the requirements and responsibilities as listed above.
2. Attach a photocopy of the ensemble director's MENC membership card.
3. Submit one short unedited CD recording made during this present school year. Recordings can be part of a rehearsal or performance and should be brief (5-10 minutes maximum) of 1-2 representative pieces.
4. Submit one letter of endorsement, from the building principal or the music/arts supervisor.
